## **Supply List**

All the supplies necessary to complete a pastel painting on the street will be provided. However, for their own convenience and comfort, artists may want to consider bringing some additional items. Here's a list:

## Supplies provided:

**Pastels.** These have been chosen for their non-toxic properties, no other pastels may be used.

Carpet squares (to blend pastels)

Baby wipes (for cleaning up with...pastels are messy! :-)

Cardboard (to sit on)

Latex gloves

Rinse water and water buckets

Trash bags

**Brooms** 

**Drinking water** 

**NOT provided:** artists should consider bringing these themselves.

You'll be sitting or kneeling on asphalt for long periods, so we highly recommend a **cushion**, **kneepads**, **Garden Kneelers or something else** to protect your knees and/or bum. One artist at a recent event brought a skateboard with a cushion on it, which he used to sit on and scoot around his drawing.

A spray bottle can be used to wet the asphalt or the pastels.

**Sunscreen and/or a wide-brimmed hat.** Because the shade on Battle Street comes and goes. Please no canopies or umbrellas; they block the public's view.

A chair to sit on when you need a break.

Brushes. Use these instead of your fingers to blend small areas.

Drinks, snacks and lunch; or money. Manassas has several places to find great food.

CD/MP3 player (with earphones only) if you like a little music.
